



LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Friends,

Thank you for making the results in this Impact Report possible. I'll say this a million times: **We cannot do this work without your help!** To every person who gifted, and every volunteer at a gift market, I'm eternally grateful to you for doing your part in helping us making this happen.

While the most recent Sustainable Development Goal progress report indicates great strides in some goal areas, there are some areas that require more work and effort. Each of our cause categories directly impact these results. In 2017 death rates for age 5-years and under dropped from 9.8 million (in 2000) to 5.4 million. Tuberculosis rates declined by 21% (2000-2017), and measles related deaths dropped 80% because adequate healthcare and vaccinations were available in rural impoverished areas. Yet, sub-Saharan Africa and Southern Asia is still home to two thirds of undernourished people worldwide. Many of the same areas of the world still lack access to safe clean water, and there are still great inequalities in education for girls.

While we are inspired by what we have accomplished together in 2018-19, we are also driven to make a **bigger** impact next year. We hope you will join us. We need you.




OUR MISSION:




