



# 1 HEALTHY HARVESTS

BELIZE, HONDURAS, PANAMA



Slash-and-burn farming in Central America has degraded the soil that many rely on to feed their families. To boost fertility, some farmers use harsh chemicals.

With support from **Sustainable Harvest International** Field Trainers, Karen Meza—a farmer in San Benito, Honduras—has chosen a different path. Karen learned about composting, natural and organic soil additives, pest control, and building agro-forestry systems through this program.

By implementing new techniques, she can offer a diverse range of healthy food and restore the soil for generations to come. Your gift can help struggling farmers like Karen to improve their livelihood and community.

# 2 COMMUNITY FOOD GARDENS

HAITI



Bigue is one of the driest rural areas in Haiti. Despite the lack of rain, people in Bigue are primarily involved in agricultural activities. Local agronomists and community members chose to tackle the lack of garden yields in a collective effort.

The **Quixote Center** partnered with the community to create a tree nursery using local materials, including cast-off wood and palm fronds. A team of agronomists teach the community how to maintain the nursery, including land preparation and water conservation techniques. Your gift can help more communities in Haiti grow thriving gardens.

# 3 RELIEF FOR REFUGEES

## HUNGARY



Millions of Ukrainians have been displaced by war with Russia. As of June 1st, 2022, the UN Refugee Agency reported that 698,420 refugees have entered Hungary. Many of these refugees are from the area of Ukraine close to Hungary and speak Hungarian. Most need shelter, food, clothing and employment.

The **Hungarian Evangelical Fellowship** (HEF) maintains schools along the Ukrainian border. On the first day of the war, the HEF provided temporary shelter in these schools. The refugees eventually reached Budapest, the largest city in Hungary. There, the HEF provided accommodations, meals, medical care, and employment support for up to 120 refugees each day. Some have received services since the beginning of the war, while others leave after a few days. The HEF also helps them navigate the social-support system of Hungary and find employment.

# 4 WASTE NOT, WANT NOT

## BOLIVIA



**Mano a Mano** collects usable medical supplies and equipment, which would otherwise be discarded in local landfills, and ships them to Bolivia. Results of this program include reduced maternal and infant mortality in marginalized communities as well as mobility for people living with disabilities. The availability of adequate supplies also makes it possible to retain staff.

Gustavo, (pictured above) with his mother Maira, recently received a free wheelchair. Maira shared that she searched for years to find a wheelchair to fit Gustavo:

**"I have been working so hard to find something. This beautiful wheelchair for me is a blessing because my son is going to be more comfortable; this wheelchair is perfect."**

# 5 NURTURING NATIVE LANDS

TRIBAL LANDS, USA



**Trees, Water & People** in collaboration with the Tri-Pueblo Coalition (comprised of Cochiti, Jemez, and Santo Domingo Pueblos), facilitates tribal land restoration projects. These address negative ecological impacts stemming from the 2011 Las Conchas wildfire, in which more than 156,600 acres of land in the Jemez Mountains was destroyed.

James Calabaza, his uncle and younger cousin, agreed that planting trees on ancestral homelands of Santo Domingo Pueblo last year meant connecting their spirits and honoring loved ones lost to the Covid-19 pandemic. The Calabazas are proud to have three generations of stewards engaged in tree planting! Your gift provides the necessary seedlings and tools to restore valuable indigenous land.

# 6 LITERACY AND LIBRARIES

ETHIOPIA



In response to school closures and Covid-19 constraints, **Ethiopia Reads** launched a successful online literacy and reading program in Amharic. This accompanies their mobile library program by using digital media channels like Facebook, YouTube and Telegram. The content includes reading tips, information on Ethiopia Reads projects, and videos of public figures reading storybooks in local languages to children. Celebrities also share their experience on the power of books to motivate families to read together at home.

Through these programs, including three Donkey Mobile Libraries in Hawassa, Horse Powered Libraries in various rural locations, Children's Reading Festivals, and online resources, children can achieve genuine literacy. Your gift offers an opportunity for children to dream big and keep learning.

EGYPT



Few opportunities exist for people with disabilities in many parts of the world. Rasha, an orphan living with a disability in Alexandria, Egypt, knows all too well how it feels to have the odds stacked against you. But that feeling went away after she was transferred from an orphanage to Fairhaven, a school supported by our partner organization **Hands Along the Nile Development Services**. There, youth with special needs receive individualized education and rehabilitation to improve their motor, cognitive, self-care, language, and speech skills.

After moving to study and live at the Fairhaven group home, Rasha blossomed into a happier and more confident person. Your support provides equal opportunity for students with disabilities to access a quality education and be self-sufficient.



Today, he is a doctor at a small medical clinic in the same village where he attended school in his youth, giving back to the community he grew up in. MYANMAR (BURMA)



Burma's forgotten war inflicts devastating pain on families and their children. Seeking to escape the army's brutal attacks, thousands of ethnic minorities seek sanctuary in isolated villages or internally displaced person camps. In addition to injuries from the war, displaced people suffer from illnesses and conditions that require medical attention. The lack of healthcare supplies and medicine can turn a minor condition into something lethal.

**Burma Humanitarian Mission** (BHM) trains traveling medic teams and offers supplies for life-saving care. Your gift supports backpack medics who treat various conditions ranging from malaria, dysentery, infections, landmine injuries and post-partum complications.

DR CONGO



Only 50% of the children in the Democratic Republic of Congo can attend primary school due to abject poverty. The percentage is significantly lower among children that are physically handicapped. Because damages misconceptions persist in society regarding their capabilities, they are often abused, neglected, and ostracized.

**StandProud** helps children with disabilities attain maximum mobility and dignity through the crafting of simple orthopedic leg braces and teaching the children how to use them; significantly improving their health and well-being. Providing leg braces for a child helps prevent them from being strategically discriminated against, offering hope and greater opportunities for their future!

When Rachael lost her second child after birth, she became so depressed she didn't want to live anymore. After receiving a Comfort Cub from another mother who had lost a child, it gave her hope that she too could survive. She and her first-born child took turns sleeping with the Comfort Cub, and it gave them hope to carry on.

New problems can appear, or small problems can get worse—which can even lead to blindness. To avoid this, children need regular eye care.

# 13 CLEAN WATER FOR COMMUNITIES

## SOUTH SUDAN



South Sudan became independent from Sudan in 2011 after fighting the longest and deadliest civil war in Africa. The war caused displacement on a large scale, forcing millions to live in horrific conditions as a result. In addition to tribal conflicts, climate changes also negatively impact villagers when they experience dry seasons (lasting up to six months). Furthermore, a lack of access to media outlets, rampant rumors, and widespread illiteracy, makes hygiene education a challenge.

**Water for South Sudan** directly addresses the evolving needs of communities by drilling new wells, repairing old wells, providing hygiene training, and building latrines. Your gift will help villagers maintain good health and thrive.

The Nepalese government only formally recognizes 47.2% of Indigenous communities. This contributes to Indigenous Peoples' unequal access to citizenship, rights, social services, and life-saving aid following worsening climate disasters.

**MADRE** partners with National Indigenous Women Forum to advance the rights and leadership of Indigenous women and girls.

This program provides the tools and skills necessary to maintain a sustainable and flourishing farm. It improves Indigenous communities' economic security, enabling women to send their children to school, cover household expenses, and strengthen their voices to advocate for their rights and improve community conditions.

# 16 MIDWIVES AND MOTHERS

HAITI



With limited resources, finances, and fear of poor care in hospitals, many women in La Plaine, Haiti deliver their babies at home. Most of these deliveries are by self-taught midwives (or family members), who lack sterile supplies to ensure a safe and healthy birth.

**Partners in Development** works to educate local midwives and equip them with the tools they need to perform safe deliveries. The midwives monitor each pregnancy for complications. When a pregnancy is high-risk, they develop a plan to ensure the mother gets the proper care she needs. Each midwife receives safe birthing kits monthly. Your gift helps reduce infant and maternal mortality rates.

# 17 PEDALING OUT OF POVERTY

NAMIBIA, ZAMBIA, TANZANIA



Something as simple as a bike is life-changing for rural villagers in Africa. Imagine walking for hours to get even the most basic necessities. A six-mile walk to a clinic to get critical medication takes two hours each way. On a bike, it only takes 15 minutes!

**Bicycles for Humanity** (B4H) seeks to change the world by delivering 1,600-2,000 bikes to community-based bike shops in Africa each year. The profits from the bike shops remain in the local communities. B4H also focuses on female empowerment; two of the bike shops are led and fully staffed by women.

This funding aids in mobilizing skilled labor, sending medical supplies, providing food, and more.

Last year, AGI partnered with International Relief Teams and raised nearly \$5,000 to assist families displaced by the war in Ukraine. As a result, families who had lost everything received food, water, shelter, and other critical supplies. Your gift to this program alleviates suffering caused by unexpected disasters that disrupt lives around the world.

Harriet’s **“Alternative Gift”** model allows people to give a gift of dignity; a hand up to those who are suffering so that they may work toward self-sufficiency.

When Harriet organized the first gift market, children and adults sold relief and self-development goods and animals for communities in developing nations. Cards were inscribed with the gifts purchased and sent to friends and relatives to inform them that an alternative gift was given in their honor.

Today, we have many helpers volunteering to achieve the mission, but to continue the mission, we need your help. Our dedicated supporters are essential to help us deliver relief and support to the poorest of the poor. Alternative gifts go beyond just the moment you give.

## Inspire Change in Your Family



Last December, Mary Waterbury and her grandsons—Cullen, Liam, Ryan and John—held the 17th annual “5 Guys for AGI” gift market. Before the pandemic, their fundraiser was a curbside hot chocolate sale for Causes in our catalog. Fortunately, COVID didn’t stop them; they made a **bigger** impact. Their 2021 gift market was an online crowdfunding page in which they successfully raised **\$1,211**, exceeding their goal of \$800! *Additionally, the nomination for their favorite local food bank was accepted, resulting in a \$2,000 grant from AGI.*

It only takes one *inspired* person to inspire a family, church, or community. The boys have agreed to continue the tradition with their own families in the future.
