WHAT IS ALTERNATIVE GIFTS INTERNATIONAL?

Alternative Gifts International (AGI) is a nonprofit organization with a mission to inspire support for humanitarian and environmental causes. For over 35 years, we have worked with carefully selected partner agencies around the world to offer donors the option to designate charitable gifts in the name of their relatives, friends, and associates.

Each year, AGI develops a global shopping list designed to meet the needs of hungry, sick, and homeless people and our endangered planet. The gifts on the list are unique and life-giving — gifts of peace and justice that are sustainable and create stability for those suffering. These alternative gifts multiply and grow, sometimes exponentially, and offer hope and new life to people facing grave crisis and need.

WHO/WHAT IS A CHAMPION FOR CHANGE?

Anyone who sees a problem in the world and wants to do something about is a Champion for Change!

The Champions for Change program invites kids to help make the world a better place by fundraising for causes that provide hunger relief, quality education, health and well-being, peace and justice, and more. The program is a great opportunity to teach kids about global issues and the importance of compassion and engages kids to take action to help others in need.

Young people can make a difference by using their interests and talents to serve others through fun and creative gift market fundraisers. By planning an alternative gift market and inviting their community to participate, kids will learn the impact they can have locally and globally.



Planning Guide

DECIDE THE DETAILS: Pick the date and time, duration, and location of your Alternative Gift Market. Select which Causes to support, and how many to include.

RECRUIT HELP: Ask your friends, family, or classmates to help you with the gift market event. The number and type of volunteers may vary depending on how many Causes you've selected, but you might get help with:

- coordinating and planning
- decorating and staffing tables/booths
- processing payments at a check-out area
- setting up and tearing down the event
- telling the community about the market
- making the market fun with music, food, decorations, and entertainment

GET RESOURCES: Download free resources form alternativegifts.org/giving/gift-markets, including posters, gift inserts (for shoppers to give to their gift recipients), safety guidelines, promotional materials, gift catalogs, and more.

LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES: Read about each charitable Cause you have chosen, and learn more about big concepts like hunger relief, eradicating poverty, the environment, and more! If you are curious about anything, search for answers to your questions. Use the activities in this pack to explore the concepts further and print them off for others at your market to use.

SPREAD THE WORD: Make sure your community knows about your market by hanging flyers, and asking friends and family to share about the event on social media and through email.

COLLECT DONATIONS: Collect orders and cash payments, and make sure any checks are written to the organization hosting the market. *One* final check with the grand total should be written to Alternative Gifts International and mailed with the remittance form to:







Connect the dots to form a picture! You will have to go over the line twice in areas where the dots have two numbers each.


